Pirates take state championship for fifth year in a row

MBHS sending California's top automotive team to national finals by Jeanne M. When you've been waiting four painful years to meet a goal, you shoot all your energies to

Morro Bay High School seniors Dave Fellows and Nathan Griffin are meeting two longplanned-for goals June 15 when they will graduate from high school and, on the same day, leave for Washington DC to compete in a national automotive contest.

Griffin and Fellows have both been waiting since they were freshman to compete in the seniors-only AAA/Plymouth Trouble Shooting contest. "They came to me before Christmas (1989) and told me their goal was to become the national champions," said Gary Villa, automotive teacher at Morro Bay High.

The best-friends team was declared best in the state May 18 after taking high score in both written and hands-on sections of the Trouble Shooting contest. In the hands-on section 1990 Plymouth Acclaims were bugged with 10 problems.

The Morro Bay team not only corrected every one of the bugs error-free, but also double-checked everything and closed the hood 11 minutes faster than any other contender. Their hood-close time was 18 minutes and 51 seconds.

In California 149 teams entered and 30 finalists (15 in the North and 15 in the South) competed to win the state title. Out of the 15 in the Southern California competition, only three teams had perfect cars and seven teams didn't even close the hood within the 1 1/2 hour deadline.

Fellows and Griffin worked hard to reach their goal.

"It's a hobby, a habit, or whatever you call it - a disease", said Fellows. Teammate Griffin added, "Cars are a hobby - you have to because you can't afford to pay a mechanic."

On their team work, "We think alike and we're totally dedicated to cars," explained Griffin. "Everything I've done, he's done because he was there."

At the state competition, Griffin and Fellows each were offered more than \$18,000 in scholarship money from various schools around the nation. They hope to keep their friendship strong and attend the same automotive school.

However, their final goals reach beyond. After automotive school both of them plan to work their way through college and eventually design cars.

Morro Bay has had a winning past in Trouble Shooting: in 1986 Morro Bay claimed first in the nation; in 1987 and in 1988 they took third in the nationals; and in 1989 they were 20th - each time after being declared California state champions.

Villa has high hopes for this team's performance in Washington, DC. "Goin in, I knew that they were going to be good," he said. To win at state and national levels Villa believes there must be a combination of things:

- The students must be able to take written exams because only top scorers are able to compete in the hands on competition. For seven weeks Griffin and Fellows spent at least an hour studying every day after school to prepare for the exam. As a result their combined test score was the highest in California.
- They must also have good mechanical aptitude. Fellows has already had 18 cars and Griffin has had one car that he had had "good luck with." Also thanks to Stanley Motors in San Luis Obispo, they were able to have a Plymouth Acclaim to practice on.
- A positive attitude is also vital. These kids think Morro Bay is successful, said Villa. "They look at al the trophies and know it can be done," he said.
- They must also set goals. "This team told me before Christmas that they were going to win the national competition," said Villa.

Two other Morro Bay contenders, Myles Blanton and Mike McGrath, attended state competition. Other area competitors in state finals were Atascadero placing ninth and Arroyo Grande placing 11th.
