

Daisy Eggs

6 Eggs

6 Rounds of Toasted Bread

$\frac{1}{2}$ Cupful of Milk

$\frac{1}{2}$ Teaspoonful of Salt

Pepper

BUTTER the toast and put it on a platter or plate which can be put into the oven. Separate the eggs, leaving each yolk separate in a small dish; beat the whites until light; pile the whites on the buttered toasted bread, which has been dipped in cold milk. With the back of a spoon make places in the white of egg and put a yolk in each; place in a hot oven for three minutes or until the eggs are set or baked to your liking. Dust with salt and
